1. Open to residents of Randolph County between the ages of 10 and 20 years old. Must be 10 years old before January 1, 2021 and not passed their 20<sup>th</sup> birthday prior to January 1, 2021
2. Females shown must be registered with the respective breed association in the name of the exhibitor (farm or joint registration is not allowed)
  - a. Registration showing age and ownership of the cattle must be shown to officials at time of show
  - b. Date of registration or date of transfer must be at least 30 days prior to the show
3. Each exhibitor is limited to not more than one (1) animal per class and can show only one (1) breed
4. No exhibitor can win more than one (1) first place cash prize with the same heifer
5. Each winner will agree to return said heifer to Randolph County farm to use for breeding purposes. Failure to comply will result in forfeiture of prize money

6. First (1<sup>st</sup>) and Second (2<sup>nd</sup>) place winners from classes 1 through 4 will be brought back in to the ring to select First (1<sup>st</sup>), Second (2<sup>nd</sup>) and Third (3<sup>rd</sup>) place females by breed.
  7. Cash Awards will be presented for top three (3) winners in the Angus, Shorthorn, and Hereford breeds
    - a. First (1<sup>st</sup>)      \$100      Second (2<sup>nd</sup>)      \$50      Third (3<sup>rd</sup>)      \$25
  8. Cash Awards for additional breeds will be prorated according to monies available from JE Bach Fund (not to exceed amounts listed in 7a.
  9. Potential development of the heifer to produce at breeding cow will be of prime importance.
  10. Any disputes will be settled by JE Bach Beef Awards Committee.
